UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITES NEARBY:

KONARK SUN TEMPLE - ANCIENT, SACRED STRUCTURES DEDICATED TO SOLAR DEITIES. THIS 13TH CENTURY TEMPLE WAS DESIGNED AS A MASSIVE CHARIOT WITH 24 INTRICATE STONE WHEELS AND SEVEN HORSES, REPRESENTING THE SUN.

DARJEELING HIMALAYAN RAILWAY - THE LINE CLIMBS FROM NEARLY SEA LEVEL TO 2,258 METERS, FEATURING STUNNING HIMALAYAN VIEWS AND ENGINEERING MARVELS LIKE THE BATASIA LOOP. IT OFFERS DAILY TOURIST SERVICES, INCLUDING STEAM-HAULED "JOY RIDES".

SUNDARBANS: KNOWN FOR ITS VAST MANGROVE FORESTS, ROYAL BENGAL TIGERS, AND UNIQUE DELTA ECOSYSTEM, ACCESSIBLE BY BOAT.

KANCHENJUNGA NATIONAL PARK IS THE ONLY MIXED HERITAGE SITE VIZ. CULTURAL AS WELL AS NATURAL










